What is it?

- Tiling window manager for X11 (Linux)
- Intended for advanced users and developers
- Oriented on keyboard control
- Simple and fast (not fancy)
- Very small footprint
- Hugely configurable
- Developed as cleaner implementation instead of wmii
- Created and developed by Michael Stapelberg since 2009
