# Task description

- `<input type="search" ... />` is rendered in some browsers (i.e. Chrome) with a “cancel X button” to clear the field and cancel searching
- In the app there is a handler for `keyUp` event on this field updating a list of corresponding addons
- After clicking the “cancel X button” the list will not update
- I should detect the “cancel X button” click and manage that the application acts same as after deleting the field manually

# My solution

- There exists a `search` event in some browsers triggered both when the search input is submitted and when user clears the field (clicks on “cancel X button”)
- Not supported by jQuery
- I manually registered the same handler for this `search` event as there had been for the `keyUp` event (while introducing the handler as a variable instead of the anonymous function)
- Modified 2 files (.latte template and .js file)

# Result acceptance

- Pull Request on Git repository
- Immediate (less than 30 min) response by two major contributors
- Short discussion and acceptance afterwards
- Merged with master branch and closed issue

# Experiences

- Pull Request on real project
- Work with GIT in general
- Look inside a Nette-based app written by members of Nette Foundation (co-authors of Nette framework)
- Planning to contribute more in the future
