


#### Entry to my project

- Adding feature to the Jedit project
- JEdit is java open source text editor
- Jedit, by default in Windows, starts after start up OS
  - It run in the background and as indication of run serves the tray icon
- In case of opening file in Jedit, background runnig allows quick start of program




# Goal of my project

- The objective was to add a feature that allows users turn off/on autostart
- Specifically, to add to the tray icon menu item that functionality allows the user to
- Project and its goal I chose myself and wrote to it feature request on sourceforge.net

# Result of my work I.

- I add the tray iccon menu item for feature
- Program find out from registry whether the autostart after startup is turned on or off. Based on this information program offers to user turning on/off
- Clicking to menu item invokes dialog window where the user confirms its intention and function is executed or not



# Result of my work II.

- Feature is working
- It works based on registry editing
- Patch was created and uploaded to patch tracker to sourceforge.net

# Result of my work III.

- OS Windows does not allow to java direct registry editing
- Java must use the command promt commands to registry editing.
- Feature work without problems (tested on more machines)

#### Changes

- 134 rows in 6 files was added
- Added Czech and English localization of feature dialogs and texts


# Work in Jedit community


- Mailing list is most used for communication in Jedit project community

  For example solving bugs or feature requests


#### Illustration – how it works
