# PhpMyAdmin feature request #1412

Ability to create table view from empty set of SQL results



# Before

✓ MySQL returned an empty result set (i.e. zero rows). ( Query took 0.0001 sec )

```
SELECT *  
FROM price  
WHERE 0  
LIMIT 0 , 30
```

Run SQL query/queries on database myhotelsystemscom1: 

```
1 select * from price where 0
```

```
SELECT *  
FROM price  
WHERE 0  
LIMIT 0 , 30
```
