ABOUT BOOTSTRAP

- Bootstrap is the HTML, CSS, and JS framework for developing responsive, mobile first projects on the web.
- Bootstrap is the most-starred project on [GitHub](#), with over 93K stars and more than 40K forks.
- Aims to ease the development of [dynamic websites](#) and [web applications](#).
- Bootstrap ships with vanilla CSS, but its source code utilizes the two most popular CSS preprocessors, [Less](#) and [Sass](#).

HOW TO CONTRIBUTE

- Fork the project & clone
- Create a new topic branch to contain feature, change, or fix
- Commit and locally merge
- Push topic branch up to your fork
- Open a Pull Request with a clear title and description


PULL REQUEST BOTS

- [@twbs-rorschach](#) is a Bootstrap bot that hangs out in our GitHub issue tracker and automatically checks all pull requests for a few simple common mistakes.
- [@twbs-savage](#) is a Bootstrap bot that automatically runs cross-browser tests (via [Sauce](#) and Travis CI) on JavaScript pull requests.
- Savage will leave a comment on pull requests stating whether cross-browser JS tests passed or failed, with a link to the full Travis build details.

- Review update jQuery to v1.12.3
- Fix: No -webkit and -moz vendor prefixes for @viewport #19871
 - The documentation of using at [https://github.com/twbs/bootstrap/...](https://github.com/twbs/bootstrap/) was incorrect.
- Clicking scrollbar in <select multiple> with overflowed options will select nearby <option> in Chrome #19810
 - Tested reliability of issue on Windows 10 in Chrome 50.0.2661.102 m.
