muCommander (description)

- ✓ **lightweight, cross-platform file manager featuring a Norton Commander style interface (dual-pane)**
- ✓ **runs on any system with Java support (Mac OS X, Windows, Linux, *BSD, Solaris, ...)**
- ✓ **free software (GPL)**



muCommander (ohloh analysis)

-  mostly written in Java (95%)
-  mature, well-established code base
-  well-commented source code
-  decreasing year-over-year development activity

muCommander (features)

- ✓ virtual filesystem with support for local volumes, FTP, SFTP, SMB, NFS, HTTP, Amazon S3, Hadoop HDFS and Bonjour
- ✓ quickly copy, move, rename files, create directories, email files...
- ✓ browse, create and uncompress ZIP, RAR, 7z, TAR, GZip, BZip2, ISO/NRG, AR/Deb and LST archives
- ✓ ZIP files can be modified on-the-fly, without having to recompress the whole archive
- ✓ highly configurable (themes)
- ✓ available in 23 languages



muCommander (how to contribute?)

- ✓ for Java developers there is a lot of issues/custom queries (tickets) that are worth fixing/implementing
- ✓ anyone can submit a patch for a new feature/bug fix, then, developers decide whether it will be committed as it is (or after minor adjustments) or will be refused – write access to the repository has to be earned!
- ✓ a non-java developer may contribute by:
 - ✓ making/maintaining documentation
 - ✓ reporting an issue/submitting a new feature request
 - ✓ doing an artwork (icons, images, ...)
 - ✓ making translations



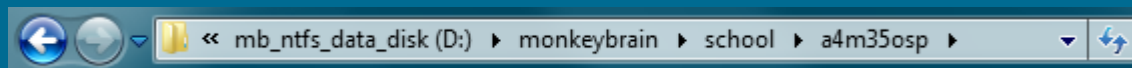
muCommander (project/team)

- ✓ **the muCommander sources are kept in a SVN repository**
 - ✓ svn checkout <https://svn.mucommander.com/mucommander> mucommander (read-only)
- ✓ **the [trac] is used as an issue tracking system, it is also the center of the muCommander community and is intended for users and contributors alike.**
 - ✓ muCommander[trac]: <http://trac.mucommander.com/>
- ✓ **the development team communicates through an IRC channel, forums, and emails**

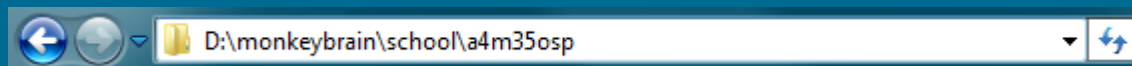


muCommander (breadcrumb bar)

- ✓ the goal of my assignment is to implement a (location-based) breadcrumb bar, which is going to replace the existing (plane) location text field



- ✓ one of objectives is to keep the former functionality of the location text field (basically, the bar has to be editable)
