any effort is very welcome! There are currently 93 bugs, 22 patches and some tasks open. Unfortunately, this list grew so much in the last year-and-half (since my son was born and some other things kept me distracted me from working on lwIP), that I currently don't have a good overview on what's unsolved versus not reviewed. There are many bugs and patches which are simply not reviewed but won't take me much time to get them committed.

Our IPv6 implementation could need some attention (DHCPv6, DNS), but aside from that, I guess the best effort would be for you to go through the bug list and see what's worth it...

Oh, another big thing would be to get a decent solution for full zero-copy (there's at least one task for this), but I don't really have an idea of how to solve this...
