- Consistently call Unicode Win32 functions, and define UNICODE globally


LibreOffice - overview

- office suite consists of 6 applications
(Writer, Calc, Impress, Draw, Math, Base)
- Windows, Linux, MacOS
- over 114 language localizations
- MPL & LGPLv3 license
- actual release 4.2.2 (libreoffice.org)

LibreOffice - deeper

- written in C++ / Java / XML
- source code stored on git
- well documented
