 - Summary -> If you want to do it by yourself create initial pull request rather than issue, otherwise someone could overtake you.

 - Purposed 2 possible solutions how to deal with a problem.
 - Implemented, tested, accepted by project member & merged into project.
- [#13 - Nette\Database - Primary key with value 0 \(zero\)](#)
 - Fixed & prepared pull request.
 - Before push I'll have to add test cases.

My contribution

- [#3 - Nette\Deprecated - Added .gitattributes file](#)
 - Added .gitattributes file into root of project.
 - Thanks to that, composer will no longer download test files in non-dev mode.
 - Accepted by team member & merged into project.
- [#12 - Zenify\DoctrineMigrations - Added support for PHP 5.4](#)
 - Implemented about month ago but before I created pull request someone overtook me.
 - Summary -> rejected, duplicat to #11.

- My Contribution
 - 2 accepted & merged pull requests
 - 2 jerected
 - 1 - rejected due to duplicity
 - 1 - resolved by team member because he was too lazy to reply to my comments
 - 1 waiting to be finished
- What I've learned
 - How to collaborate on github
 - Improved my skills with git & composer
 - Now I'm able also rebase repository
 - Or create composer repository, etc.
 - How to write tests for Nette & use Nette\Tester
 - Improved my skills with Doctrine, especially with Doctrine\Migrations
